All campers will check-in at a remote (off camp) location. Check-in will be at the Aplin Church in Gay, WV. Check-out will be at the same location on Thursday, July 21st, at 3:00 pm. Directions are listed below.

Take I-77 to exit 132 (Fairplain – Ripley).
Turn east at the end of the ramp.
Take your first right (Cedar Lakes Road.).
Follow Cedar Lakes Road. 1 mile to the top of the hill.
Take a sharp right on to Statts Mill Road (36). (easy to pass)
Drive 12.5 miles to the Aplin Church on left.
